

# MARKET ANALYSIS: Janitorial Supplies Consumption in U.S. & Canada

Consumption of Janitorial Supplies in the U.S. was \$19.1 billion in 2010. Consumption in Canada was \$1.7 billion in 2010, according to data from Industrial Market Information.
