December 2013 compared with November 2013

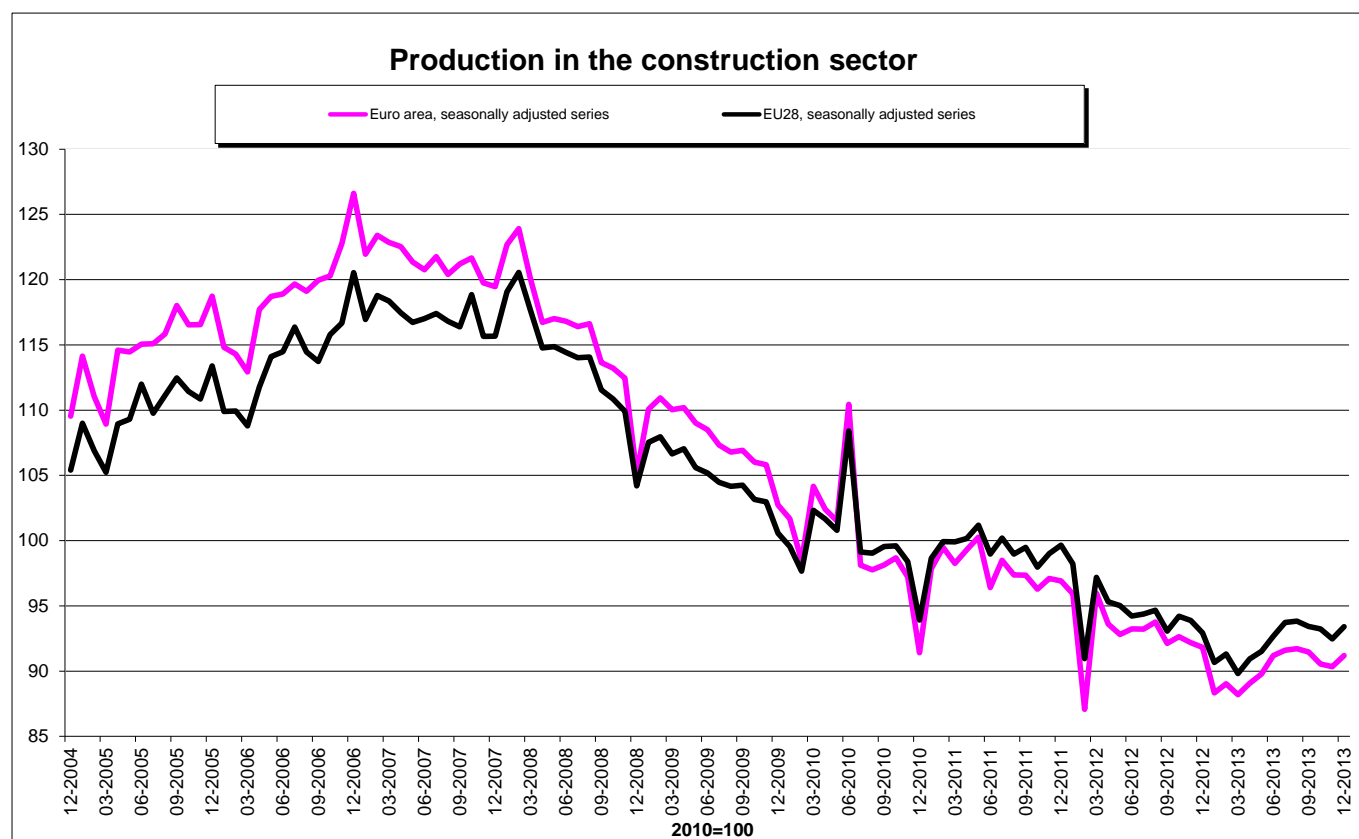
Euro area production in construction up by 0.9%

Up by 1.0% in EU28

In December 2013 compared with November 2013, seasonally adjusted production in the construction¹ sector grew by 0.9% in the **euro area**² (EA17) and by 1.0% in the **EU28**², according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In November 2013³, production in construction fell by 0.2% and 0.8% respectively.

In December 2013 compared with December 2012⁴, production in construction declined by 0.2% in the **euro area**, but rose by 0.8% in the **EU28**.

Average production in construction for the year 2013, compared with 2012, dropped by 2.9% in the **euro area** and by 2.2% in the **EU28**.



Monthly comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for December 2013, production in construction rose in nine and fell in six. The highest increases were observed in the **Czech Republic** (+6.0%), **France** (+4.5%) and **Slovakia** (+2.9%), and the largest decreases in **Slovenia** (-17.2%), **Poland** (-4.1%) and **Spain** (-3.3%).

Building construction grew by 0.6% in the **euro area** and by 0.7% in the **EU28**, after -0.7% and -1.0% respectively in November 2013. Civil engineering gained 3.8% in the **euro area** and 3.5% in the **EU28**, after +1.1% and -0.7% respectively in the previous month.

Annual comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for December 2013, production in construction fell in five and rose in ten. The largest decreases were registered in **Portugal** (-14.1%), **Italy** (-8.8%) and **Spain** (-4.7%), and the highest increases in **Hungary** (+11.5%), **Slovakia** (+9.2%) and the **United Kingdom** (+6.8%).

Building construction dropped by 0.9% in the **euro area**, but increased by 0.1% in the **EU28**, after -1.3% and -0.8% respectively in November 2013. Civil engineering rose by 1.7% in the **euro area** and by 2.3% in the **EU28**, after -2.6% and -3.7% respectively in the previous month.

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.

2. Up to 31 December 2013, the euro area (EA17) included Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland. From 1 January 2014 the euro area (EA18) also includes Latvia.
The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.
As part of Eurostat's guidelines for the dissemination of data when the euro area is enlarged, the aggregate data series commented on in this News Release refer to the official composition in the most recent month for which data is available. **Thus News Releases with data for months up to December 2013 comment on EA17 series, while Releases with data for January 2014 onwards will comment on EA18 series.**

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 8/2014 of 17 January 2014. The monthly growth rates for November 2013 have been revised from -0.6% to -0.2% for the euro area and from -1.1% to -0.8% for the EU28. The annual growth rates have been revised from -1.7% to -1.6% for the euro area and from -1.6% to -1.2% for the EU28.
