
## Construction output down by 3.1% in euro area

Down by 2.5% in the EU27

In the construction sector, seasonally adjusted production<sup>1</sup> fell by 3.1% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA16) and by 2.5% in the **EU27**<sup>2</sup> in July 2010, compared with the previous month. In June<sup>3</sup> production increased by 1.8% and 2.6% respectively.

Compared with July 2009, output in July 2010 dropped by 7.5% in the **euro area** and by 2.3% in the **EU27**.

These first estimates are released by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**.



## Monthly comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for July 2010, construction output fell in six and rose in seven. The largest decreases were registered in **Romania** (-28.3%), **Spain** (-10.3%) and **Slovenia** (-3.2%), and the highest increases in **Portugal** (+5.0%), the **United Kingdom** (+4.4%) and **Slovakia** (+2.0%).

Building construction fell by 3.3% in both the **euro area** and the **EU27**, after +1.8% and +2.9% respectively in June. Civil engineering decreased by 1.7% in the **euro area** and by 0.9% in the **EU27**, after +1.6% and +1.9% respectively in the previous month.

## Annual comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for July 2010, construction output fell in nine and rose in four. The largest decreases were registered in **Spain** (-36.5%), **Romania** (-24.9%) and **Bulgaria** (-19.0%), and the highest increases in the **United Kingdom** (+13.1%), **Sweden** (+9.4%) and **Germany** (+4.8%).

Building construction decreased by 7.9% in the **euro area** and by 2.3% in the **EU27**, after +4.6% and +6.0% respectively in June. Civil engineering dropped by 6.0% in the **euro area** and by 1.5% in the **EU27**, after -6.5% and -1.8% respectively in the previous month.

1. The production index in construction approximates the evolution of output within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. For the Member States which produce the construction index, but do not provide data for the reference period, Eurostat estimates missing values in order to calculate euro area and EU aggregates.

For total construction, and according to the Council Regulation 1165/98, Eurostat publishes national seasonally adjusted data if available. For Bulgaria, Denmark, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands and Sweden, Eurostat makes the adjustment.

The seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the working-day adjusted series from individual Member States and making an adjustment for seasonal effects on these series. Therefore, the seasonally adjusted figures for total construction are based directly on the working day adjusted series from the Member States and **not on an aggregation of the seasonally adjusted indices from the Member States**. The euro area and EU seasonally adjusted growth rates might differ from the weighted growth rates of the individual Member States.

Working-day adjusted figures are currently transmitted by most of the Member States. For Bulgaria and Denmark, Eurostat makes the working day adjustment.

If a Member State does not supply monthly data (data not required by the regulation or data required but not yet sent), Eurostat calculates the missing series by linear interpolation from quarterly data, in order to calculate the monthly European aggregates.

2. The euro area (EA16) consists of Belgium, Germany, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The EU27 includes Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK).

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release 122/2010 of 18 August 2010. The monthly growth rates for June 2010 have been revised from +2.7% to +1.8% in the euro area and from +3.5% to +2.6% in the EU27. The annual growth rates have been revised from +3.1% to +1.9% in the euro area and from +5.4% to +4.0% in the EU27.
