
Industrial new orders up by 1.5% in euro area

Up by 1.7% in EU27

In September 2009 compared with August 2009, the **euro area¹** (EA16) industrial new orders index² rose by 1.5%. In August³ the index increased by 0.6%. In the **EU27¹** new orders grew by 1.7% in September 2009, after an increase of 2.0% in August³. Excluding ships, railway & aerospace equipment⁴, for which changes tend to be more volatile, industrial new orders fell by 1.2% in the **euro area** and by 0.6% in the **EU27**.

In September 2009 compared with September 2008, industrial new orders decreased by 16.5% in the **euro area** and by 16.4% in the **EU27**. Total industry excluding ships, railway & aerospace equipment⁴ dropped by 18.2% and 17.5% respectively.

These estimates are released by **Eurostat, the Statistical Office of the European Communities**



Monthly changes

In September 2009 compared with August 2009, new orders for capital goods grew by 3.7% in the **euro area** and by 2.8% in the **EU27**. Non-durable consumer goods rose by 1.5% and 2.0% respectively. Durable consumer goods increased by 1.5% in the **euro area** and by 1.8% in the **EU27**. Intermediate goods fell by 2.1% and 0.2% respectively.

Among the Member States for which data are available, total manufacturing working on orders rose in thirteen and fell in eight. The highest increases were registered in **Denmark** (+43.0%), **Ireland** (+19.7%) and **Poland** (+9.7%), and the largest decreases in **Estonia** (-5.0%), **Portugal** (-4.9%) and **Lithuania** (-4.4%).

Annual changes

In September 2009 compared with September 2008, new orders for non-durable consumer goods fell by 4.0% in the **euro area** and by 1.4% in the **EU27**. Durable consumer goods declined by 13.0% and 6.7% respectively. Capital goods dropped by 14.5% in the **euro area** and by 16.8% in the **EU27**. Intermediate goods decreased by 22.5% and 20.7% respectively.

Total manufacturing working on orders fell in all the Member States for which data are available, except **Denmark** (+9.6%). The largest falls were registered in **Estonia** and **Lithuania** (both -42.4%), **Latvia** and **Finland** (both -31.0%), and the lowest decreases in **France** (-5.8%), **Ireland** (-11.5%) and **Sweden** (-12.9%).

1. The euro area (EA16) includes Belgium, Germany, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The EU27 includes Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK).

2. The new orders index measures the value of future deliveries of products and services (which are directly linked to these products) to be provided by a producer to a third party on the domestic and non-domestic market. The total manufacturing aggregate includes only those NACE levels required by the STS Regulation to be supplied by the Member States (NACE 13, 14, 17, 20, 21, 24 to 30) and is referred to as "total manufacturing working on orders". The euro area and EU aggregates normally do not include Member States for which no data is available.

The seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the unadjusted series from individual Member States and performing an adjustment for seasonal effects on these series. Therefore the seasonally adjusted figures for the European aggregates are based directly on the unadjusted series coming from the Member States and **not on an aggregation of the seasonally adjusted indices from the Member States**. The euro area and EU seasonally adjusted growth rates might differ from the weighted growth rates of the individual Member States. This procedure also implies that the aggregation of the overall figures is not based on the published details.

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in News Release 151/2009 of 23 October 2009. The figures for August 2009 were +2.0% in the euro area and +1.2% in the EU27 for the monthly changes, and -23.1% in the euro area and -22.3% in the EU27 for the annual changes.
4. New orders for heavy transport equipment (NACE 30, which includes ships, railway and aerospace equipment) tend to be very volatile with a limited immediate impact on production. The aggregate "Manufacturing working on orders excluding heavy transport equipment" is less erratic. The share of heavy transport equipment in total manufacturing working on orders is 2.9% for the euro area and 3.0% for the EU.
5. Data for Ireland is working day adjusted.
