

## Euro area production in construction down by 0.6%

Down by 1.1% in EU28

In November 2013 compared with October 2013, seasonally adjusted production in the construction<sup>1</sup> sector fell by 0.6% in the **euro area<sup>2</sup>** (EA17) and by 1.1% in the **EU28<sup>2</sup>**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In October 2013<sup>3</sup>, production in construction decreased by 1.1% and 0.3% respectively.

In November 2013 compared with November 2012<sup>4</sup>, production in construction declined by 1.7% in the **euro area** and by 1.6% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for November 2013, production in construction fell in seven and rose in eight. The largest decreases were observed in the **Czech Republic** (-5.6%), **Romania** (-4.9%) and the **United Kingdom** (-4.0%), and the highest increases in **Slovenia** (+9.6%), **Poland** (+3.9%) and **Hungary** (+3.0%).

Building construction fell by 1.1% in the **euro area** and by 1.4% in the **EU28**, after -0.6% and -0.3% respectively in October 2013. Civil engineering rose by 1.0% in the **euro area**, but decreased by 0.3% in the **EU28**, after -1.6% and +0.8% respectively in the previous month.

## Annual comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for November 2013, production in construction fell in nine, remained stable in **Germany** and rose in five. The largest decreases were registered in **Portugal** (-13.0%), **Italy** (-10.8%), **Bulgaria** (-9.1%) and the **Czech Republic** (-8.3%), and the highest increases in **Slovenia** (+30.7%), **Hungary** (+18.9%) and **Sweden** (+5.9%).

Building construction dropped by 1.4% in both the **euro area** and the **EU28**, after -2.0% and -0.7% respectively in October 2013. Civil engineering fell by 3.1% in the **euro area** and by 3.2% in the **EU28**, after -3.9% and -2.6% respectively in the previous month.

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.

2. Up to 31 December 2013, the euro area (EA17) included Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland. From 1 January 2014 the euro area (EA18) also includes Latvia.

The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

As part of Eurostat's guidelines for the dissemination of data when the euro area is enlarged, the aggregate data series commented on in this News Release refer to the official composition in the most recent month for which data is available. **Thus News Releases with data for months up to December 2013 comment on EA17 series, while Releases with data for January 2014 onwards will comment on EA18 series.**

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 198/2013 of 18 December 2013. The monthly growth rate for October 2013 has been revised from -1.2% to -1.1% for the euro area and remains unchanged at -0.3% for the EU28. The annual growth rates have been revised from -2.4% to -2.3% for the euro area and from -0.8% to -1.0% for the EU28.
