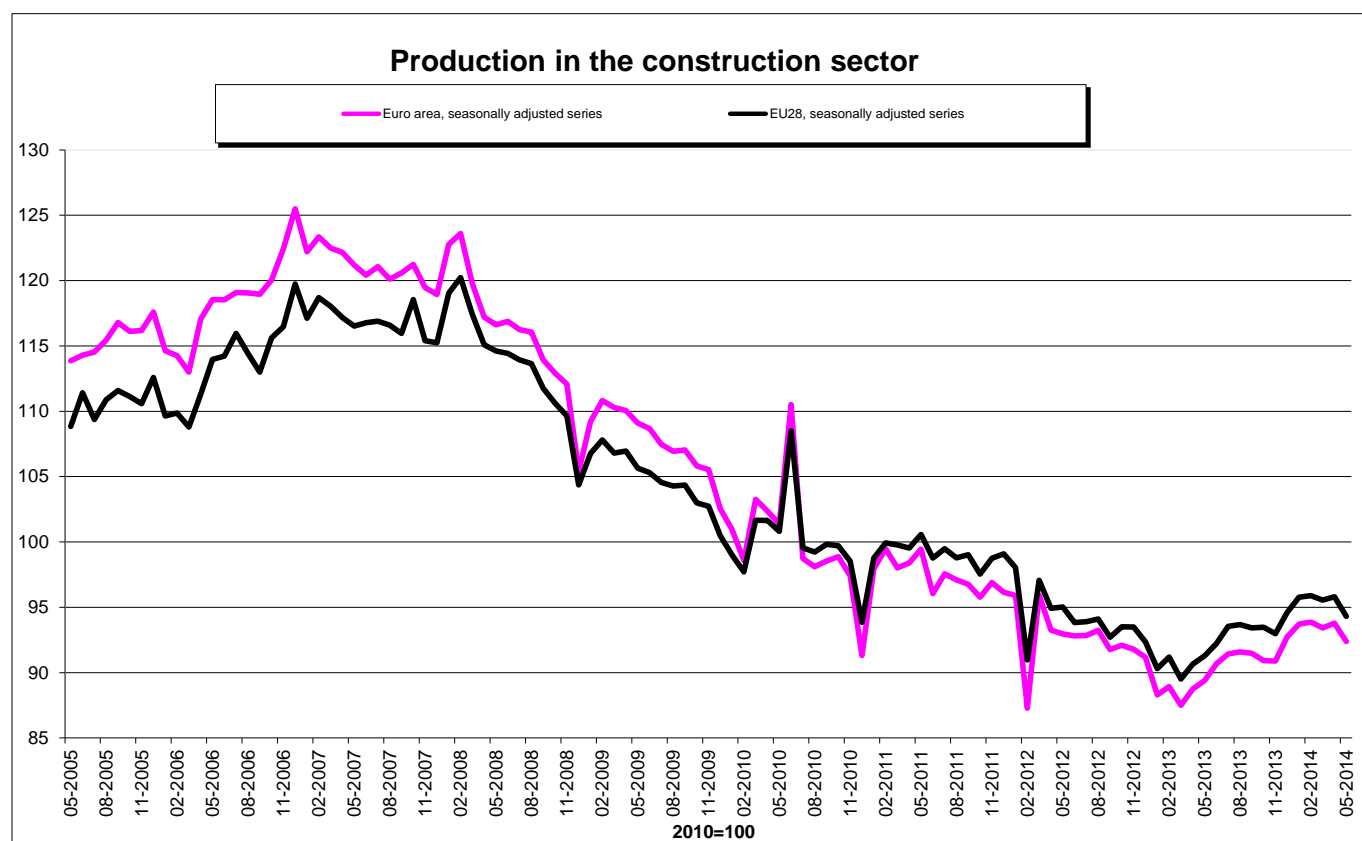
May 2014 compared with April 2014

Production in construction down by 1.5% in euro area

Down by 1.6% in EU28

In May 2014 compared with April 2014, seasonally adjusted production in the construction¹ sector fell by 1.5% in the **euro area**² (EA18) and by 1.6% in the **EU28**², according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In April 2014³, production in construction rose by 0.4% and 0.3% respectively.

In May 2014 compared with May 2013⁴, production in construction increased by 3.5% in the **euro area** and by 3.2% in the **EU28**.



Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 1.5% in production in construction in the **euro area** in May 2014, compared with April 2014, is due to civil engineering falling by 3.0% and building construction by 1.1%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 1.6% is due to civil engineering falling by 2.4% and building construction by 1.2%.

The largest decreases in production in construction were observed in **Germany** (-4.9%), **Poland** (-3.9%), **Slovenia** (-3.7%) and the **Czech Republic** (-3.6%), while increases were registered in **Hungary** (+2.3%), **Bulgaria** (+1.7%), **Slovakia** (+1.6%) and **Spain** (+1.0%).

Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The increase of 3.5% in production in construction in the **euro area** in May 2014, compared with May 2013, is due to building construction rising by 5.3% while civil engineering fell by 2.6%.

In the **EU28**, the increase of 3.2% is due to building construction rising by 5.0% while civil engineering dropped by 2.5%.

The highest increases in production in construction were registered in **Spain** (+42.4%), **Slovenia** (+41.8%), **Hungary** (+28.7%) and **Poland** (+6.8%), and the largest decreases in **Romania** (-10.3%), **Portugal** (-10.2%), the **Netherlands** (-4.0%) and **Germany** (-2.5%).

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.

The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 95/2014 of 18 June 2014. The monthly growth rates for April 2014 have been revised from +0.8% to +0.4% for the euro area and from +0.6% to +0.3% for the EU28. The annual growth rates have been revised from +8.0% to +7.4% for the euro area and from +7.2% to +7.1% for the EU28.
