



September 2016 compared with August 2016

Production in construction down by 0.9% in euro area Down by 0.3% in EU28

In September 2016 compared with August 2016, seasonally adjusted production in the construction sector decreased by 0.9% in the **euro area** (EA19) and by 0.3% in the **EU28**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In August 2016, production in construction grew by 0.1% in the **euro area** and fell by 0.6% in the **EU28**.

In September 2016 compared with September 2015, production in construction rose by 1.8% in the **euro area**, while it fell by 0.2% in the **EU28**.



Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 0.9% in production in construction in the **euro area** in September 2016, compared with August 2016, is due to building construction falling by 1.1%, while civil engineering rose by 0.4%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 0.3% is due to building construction falling by 0.7%, while civil engineering rose by 1.8%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in production in construction were recorded in **Italy** (-3.9%), **Slovakia** (-3.1%) and **Portugal** (-2.2%), and the highest increases in **Slovenia** (+4.0%), **Poland** (+3.3%) and **Sweden** (+3.1%).

Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The increase of 1.8% in production in construction in the **euro area** in September 2016, compared with September 2015, is due to civil engineering rising by 3.7% and building construction by 1.3%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 0.2% is due to civil engineering falling by 1.6%, while building construction grew by 0.2%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in production in construction were recorded in the **Netherlands** (+7.8%), **Sweden** (+6.1%) and **Spain** (+3.9%), and the largest decreases in **Slovakia** (-17.9%), **Poland** (-16.1%) and **Hungary** (-13.2%).

Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Croatia, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania and Malta are not required to supply monthly data under Council Regulation 1165/98.

Methods and definitions

The **index of production in construction** approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release [200/2016](#) of 19 October 2016. The monthly percentage change for August 2016 has been revised from -0.9% to +0.1% in the euro area and from -1.3% to -0.6% in the EU28. The annual percentage change has been revised from +0.9% to +2.1% in the euro area and from -0.5% to +0.1% in the EU28.
